



A- End of long bone.

Externally - Compact

Main producer of red blood cells

Internally - cancellous

Helps transfer weight

B- Middle part of bone

Diaphysis

Provides strength

C- smooth slippery end of bone

Easy to move

Joint ability to last

D- Periosteum

like skin at bone

grasp and repair

E- Cancellous bone + Marrow

- Produces red blood cells

F- Compact bone

rich in calcium

strength of bone

G- Medullary Cavity Yellow Marrow

Middle hollow part stores marrow

Major blood loss becomes Red cells

H- Nutritive artery

- Brings nutrients (Blood) into bone
